




Vital Statistics




653 deaths occurred in Knox County in 2020. Heart related remained leading cause of death, followed by cancer. There was a **106% increase** in cancer deaths from 2019 (63) to 2020, with the leading cause remaining lung cancer. There were **51 COVID-19 deaths** in the county in 2020.







WIC's total average caseload for 2020 was **840**, this is a **13%** decrease in caseload from 2019.


In 2020, **134 individuals** received some form of nutrition education (Group, Individual, High-Risk) on average per month




