

HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2022

Our role at Knox Public Health is everchanging, complex and challenging, yet what remains constant is our commitment to protect the public's health and lead efforts to improve the overall health and well-being of the entire community. In 2022, KPH successfully conducted its day-to-day operations, as well as:

- Welcomed new Health Commissioner, Zach Green
- Acquired land in downtown Mount Vernon to develop into one central location for Public Health and Health Center services
- Hired a full time epidemiologist to study patterns and causes of disease
- Started a Community Health Worker program to provide support to families and advocate for individual health needs
- Launched "Health on Wheels," a podcast to highlight how public health helps communities
- Expanded Behavioral Health services and hired additional medical providers in our Federally Qualified Health Center improving access to care for over 4,000 Knox County residents

A LOOK AHEAD


As we look ahead to serving the community in 2023, we are planning some exciting things, including:


- The development of a training course on the social determinants of health for our community partners
