	Obesity Prevention: Tami Reviewed team accomplishments to date. Sara Butz attended past two meetings to review current A3 and to offer team guidance as to what is their "next step". Team will be reviewing and refining current goal. Possibly ask each worksite wellness organization to set a SMART goal for their site. The team is also looking into holding a Worksite Wellness Workshop in January or February of 2018.	
2018 CHA (Community Health Assessment)	KHPP group was identified in 2010, first CHA 2011. Modeled off assessments from local United Way 2005-2006.	
• MAPP (Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships) - Carmen Barbuto	KHPP group decided that we would complete CHA every 3 years. Priorities identified by assessment remained the same in 2011 & 2014.	
	During this time Public Health Accreditation Board was formed. National Accreditation in Public Health is voluntary throughout the US except in Ohio. All Ohio health dept. must be accredited by 2020.	
	State Legislature decided that we must complete CHA and CHIP in partnership with the local hospital, which is easy to accomplish in Knox County.	
	KCH is due in 2018 to complete next health assessment. Jeff-stated additional requirement is being added to health assessment process to align with other hospitals. Hospital wants to partner with health dept. in the process.	
	Accreditation process recommends several different Community Health Assessment "models". Of the models MAPP is one of the most popular to use. It is simple and builds partnerships. Julie is recommending that we use this process. From a hospital perspective, MAPP is the model that the state is requiring them to use in the assessment process.
