No site evaluation fee shall be refunded after any work has been performed for the site evaluation. All other fees may be refunded if no work has been done or service rendered. All refunds shall be subject to a deduction of \$10.00 to cover administrative costs of the refund.

TRANSFER OF PERMITS, LICENSES, AND REGISTRATIONS PROHIBITED

No license, permit, or registration that has been issued may be transferred to another person or entity.

This fee schedule is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of life, health and safety for the reason that fees need to be established to partially defray the cost of providing vital public health services in the Knox County General Health District; therefore, this fee schedule shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the date of approval by the Board of Health.

All elements of the fee schedule will be reviewed annually.
